Did You Know?

- ◆ That approximately 2,000 local soccer enthusiasts use the park district's facilities each year?
- ◆ That the multi-purpose facility proposed for Ackerman Park would be perfect for indoor soccer?
- ◆ That we could provide additional soccer facilities for the entire community at NO ADDITIONAL COST to taxpayers?



Total Referendum Request: \$11.9 million

- ◆ For every \$100,000 in market value, the referendum would cost \$23.31 per year to the property owner. This means if the proposed referendum does not pass, you will realize a savings as illustrated by the following table.

Fair Market Value	Tax Impact With Referendum	Savings Without Referendum
\$200,000	\$0	(\$46.62)
\$300,000	\$0	(\$69.93)
\$400,000	\$0	(\$93.24)
\$500,000	\$0	(\$116.55)
\$600,000	\$0	(\$139.86)
