



Tax question under review

Glen Ellyn Park District officials are expecting to approve the placement of a tax referendum question on the November ballot. Park district board members are seeking to get the public's approval for bond money that will help pay for land acquisition, renovation to the Main Street Recreation Center, an addition to the Lake Ellyn Boathouse and washrooms and shelters at Ackerman Park. None of the proposals have received approval from the board yet, but officials said these four projects are at the top of their list and are hopeful plans will be carried out. If residents approve the referendum, the tax rate would remain equivalent to what it has been since the 1999 bonds, but the pay-off date would be rolled over to 2014.
