

**Glen Ellyn Park District Board of Commissioners honor volunteer
Lillian Haugland**

Glen Ellyn, IL - Glen Ellyn Park District commissioners recognized long-time volunteer Lillian Haugland for her years of contributions to the park district and other community organizations at its workshop meeting May 4.

A Glen Ellyn resident, Haugland has touched the lives of hundreds of people throughout the past 23 years. Her many contributions include:

- Volunteering for the Glen Ellyn Park District senior luncheons;
- Volunteering for Central DuPage Hospital at the Wise Penny Resale Shop in Wheaton;
- Helping residents at DuPage Convalescent Center with ceramics;
- Visiting homebound residents, bring them meal, giving them cards and spending time with them;
- Donating the produce she grows in her own garden to the Glen Ellyn Pantry;
- Knitting shawls for the homebound and hospital inpatients through Faith Lutheran Church, where she has been a member for more than 57 years.

Haugland received the Paul Herwaldt Senior Award at the 2010 Community Awards Breakfast, hosted by the Glen Ellyn Chamber of Commerce and the Glen Ellyn Jaycees at the Crowne Plaza Glen Ellyn April 17. The event is held annually to recognize “individuals who best represent the spirit of volunteer service to the community, and who have made a continuing positive impact on the quality of life in Glen Ellyn.”

Park board president Ed Hess presented Haugland with a plaque inscribed with the proclamation:
